1.1 CONTENT OF THE TENDERS

All applications, correspondence and documents related to the tender exchanged by the tenderer and the Contracting Authority should be written in English.

1.2 ELIGIBILITY AND SUITABILITY CRITERIA

The suitability and eligibility criteria specified in paragraphs 1.2.1-1.2.3 below must be complete and without limitation or modification with the submission of the bid. Any such criterion not completely confirmed and fulfilled by the bidder will lead to exclusion from further evaluation. Only those bidders and bids that fulfil all formal requirements on suitability and eligibility criteria will be evaluated. The other bidders and bids will be excluded from the further procedure

1.2.1 Educational Qualifications of the proposed resource(s)

The proposed resource(s) should be in possession of at least but not limited to a relevant minimum NQF 6 Tertiary qualification in the Built Environment.

1.2.2 Technical capacity and capability of the resource

 Bidders must submit a Technical Proposal/Methodology with a minimum of 3 pages and a maximum of 5 pages; and A short description of relevant projects previously undertaken by the resource(s) and at least three (3) contactable references on projects completed. (Description of Projects must not be more than 500 words each), (Details to should be provided using Annexure D template.)

1.2.3 Submission of CVs

Curriculum Vitae should be completed using Annexure E template. Companies are allowed to tender for the positions on condition that the company submits **NO MORE** than **two (2) curriculum vitae** for the positions being applied for.

The suitability criteria specified above must be complete and without limitation or modification with the submission of the bid. Any such criterion not completely confirmed and fulfilled by the bidder leads to exclusion from further evaluation. Only those bidders and bids that fulfil all formal requirements and suitability criteria will be evaluated. The other bidders and bids will be excluded from the further procedure.

1.3 APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

- 1.3.1 Bidders should provide up to 1 (one) A4 page that contains a short history and experience of the resource(s) with specific reference to the experience required in terms of these Terms of Reference;
- 1.3.2 Bidders must submit CV's on the template provided herein with certified copies of qualifications of all resources to be provided; *Annexure E template*
- 1.3.3 The bidder must submit a detailed Project Delivery Methodology:
- 1.3.4 The bidder should submit a reference for relevant projects previously undertaken by the resource(s) in support of proven experience (*Details to be provided using Annexure D template*)
- 1.3.5 The Bidder must ensure that it provides a determinable costing (*using Annexure C template*) of the services associated with each resource.

1.4 FINANCIAL OFFERS (ANNEXURE C TEMPLATE)

Financial offers must be provided in a separately using Annexure C costing template. All offers should be in ZAR.

Incidental expenditure (Travel and related) incurred by the contractor will be reimbursed at cost and subject to the provisions and set limitations of the PINKs Operating Manual. These should not be included in Annexure C costing template as they will be cost recovery.

1.5 AWARD AND EVALUATION OF TENDERS

STAGE 2 - PROPOSED METHODOLOGY AND APPROACH/PROJECT MANAGEMENT (100)

Methodology – Minimum score required is 75 =GOOD

The proposed methodology and approach paper must respond to the scope of work and outline the proposed approach / methodology. The bidder must submit a detailed project plan that has deliverables linked to timelines on the Project delivery methodology. The paper should incorporate the following key aspects:

- Clear understanding of the project objective and key deliverables;
- Concise and logical conceptualization of the relevant outcomes; and
- Practical and innovative institutionalization of the project plan
